

AICTE Pragati & Saksham Scholarship schemes

PART I - Eligibility

A. AICTE Pragati (Degree & Diploma):

1) The girl candidate should be admitted to **First year of Degree/Diploma level course**

OR

Second year of Degree/Diploma level course through lateral entry only in any of the AICTE approved Institutions of respective year.

2) Maximum two girl child per family are eligible.

3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by the State/ UT Government needs to be enclosed.

4) **Must have taken admission in AICTE approved institutions and AICTE approved courses only.**

5) The gap period between the year of passing the qualifying examination and the session of admission in a degree/diploma course shall not be more than two years i.e. Students must have cleared 10+2/10th in 2020 or 2019 or 2018 for taking admission in the first year in Degree/Diploma courses respectively in the current academic year. Similarly, for students taking admission in second year directly through lateral entry only in Degree/Diploma in the current academic year, they must have cleared diploma/ITI respectively in 2020 or 2019 or 2018.

B. AICTE Saksham (Degree & Diploma):-

1) The candidate should be admitted to First year of Degree/Diploma level course

OR

Second year of Degree/Diploma level course through lateral entry only in any of the AICTE approved Institutions of respective year.

2) Specially-abled students, having a disability of not less than 40%.

3) Family income from all sources should not be more than Rs. 8 lakh per annum during the current financial year. A valid income certificate issued by the State /UT Government needs to be enclosed.

4) Must have taken admission in AICTE approved institutions and AICTE approved courses only.

5) The gap period between the year of passing the qualifying examination and the session of admission in a degree/diploma course shall not be more than two years i.e. Students must have cleared 10+2/10th in 2020 or 2019 or 2018 for taking admission in the first year in Degree/Diploma courses respectively in the current academic year. Similarly, for students taking admission in second year directly through lateral entry only in Degree/Diploma in the current academic year, they must have cleared diploma/ITI respectively in 2020 or 2019 or 2018.

Note: It has been observed that some of the institutions are verifying applications of the students who have taken admission in 2019 or earlier batches in the AICTE approved courses on the National Scholarship Portal (<http://scholarships.gov.in>). These students are not eligible for the AICTE scholarships in the current academic year.

PART II - Responsibilities of Institutions

| 1 | Verification of the Eligible candidates | Students enrolled in the AICTE approved Institutions and AICTE approved courses as per scheme guidelines are only eligible for the scholarships. Institutions shall verify the above along with other documents submitted by the applicants e.g. eligibility for the scholarships, proper entry of % of marks in 10 th / 10+2, Income certificate, Category Certificate, Maximum two girl child per family availing the above scholarship certificate, mandate form |
| 2 | Gap Period | The gap period between the year of passing the qualifying examination and the session of admission in a degree/diploma course shall not be more than two years i.e. Students must have cleared 10+2/10th in 2020 or 2019 or 2018 for taking admission in the first year in Degree/Diploma courses respectively in the current academic year. Similarly, for students taking admission in second year directly through lateral entry only in Degree/Diploma in the current academic year, they must have cleared diploma/ITI respectively in 2020 or 2019 or 2018. |
| 3 | To avoid Double/Fake Scholarship | Institutes have to ensure that the admitted student does not receive any financial assistance in shape of scholarship/any emoluments, salary, stipend etc. from any other sources during his/her course of study in the Institute. |
| 4 | Aadhaar Card | Student name & Aadhaar number should match with details in the online application & uploaded Aadhaar card. |
| 5 | Bank details verification | Institutes to ensure bank details verified on basis of following: i) Student name should match with HSC for Degree level & SSC for Diploma level mark sheet, Aadhar and Bank Details. ii) Joint bank account - Allowed iii) Minor bank account - Allowed iv) Bank account should be active with aadhaar seeded and same must be checked at aadhar website before forwarding Pragati & Saksham Scholarship application. v) Bank Pass Book or Mandate Form (If the bank details are not correct/ doesn't match with Aadhaar seeded account number) |
| 6 | Other Documents | Institute should check other documents i.e. 1. Category Certificate, 2. OBC (Non Creamy Layer - issued within one year), 3. Physically handicap certificate (for Saksham Scholarship Scheme), 4. Declaration by Parents, 5. Annual Family Income Certificate, 6. Study Certificate Issued by the Director/Principal/HOD |
