It is hereby informed that, following are the Technical requirements for appearing in the 5th semester 2020 Summer Exams in online Remote Proctoring mode.

Technical requirements

Parameter	Minimum requirements
Web browser	Latest version of Chrome / Firefox / Microsoft Edge.
Operating system	Windows 7 and above
Processor	Min 2 cores
RAM	Min 512 Mb, preferred 1-2 GB
Web camera	640x480, 15 fps / Front Camera of Mobile
Microphone	Any Suitable(usually in built to Webcam)
Screen resolution	1024 x 768 and Above for Desktop
Network bandwidth	Min 512 Kbit/s, preferred 1 Mbit/s

Other Specifications:

- Ensure that you are taking the examination in a room with proper lighting with minimal background noise.
- Examination will run only on webcam and microphone enabled Desktop or Laptop or Android-based Smart-Phone.
- It is preferred to use the latest version of Google Chrome browser / Mozilla Firefox / Microsoft Edge.
- Clear the Browser Cache before the start of the examination.
- Students should have Admin access to the computer to enable & disable the required tab.
- Ad Blocker should be switched off and auto password save shall also be disabled.
- Enable Cookies setting in Chrome.
- All applications that use camera, microphone and screen sharing should be switched off during the remote proctoring sessions.
- Popup Blocker should be turned off.
- While capturing your photo, ensure no objects / obstacles are behind you.



The candidates willing to appear from home using Android Mobile sets/Laptop/Desktop/Tab etc. are required to arrange such devices with the above features and set up as per the above specifications. Candidates are required to appear Live Mock Test from such device/exams centre wherever he/she has planned to appear in the actual Exams of 5th semester summer 2020 Exams. Appearing the Live Mock Test is compulsory to test the device/internet connectivity working in Remote proctored mode in addition to getting acquainted with on how to appear the examination online.


Live Mock Test of 5th semester Summer 2020 Exams is different from Generic Mock Test of 6th Semester Summer 2020, in the sense that, Generic Mock Test allows any candidate to appear the Mock Test any time and any number of times. SCTE&VT does not keep track of such attempts by candidates. All candidates can appear Mock Test using a common user-Id and Password provided for all candidates. But in Live Mock Test, every registered candidate shall be allowed to login for Mock Test only once using separate user Id and Password sent to his/her E-Mail Id. SCTE&VT shall maintain record of candidates who appeared the Mock Test. Mock Test shall be same as actual Examination except that the marks scored in Mock Test shall not be counted as his/her score for result computation. There shall be only one standard subject for all the candidates to appear in the Live Mock Test.

Principals of all Polytechnics are hereby requested to make adequate arrangements in their Examination Centres with the above required Technical specification and internet connectivity, so that students of their institution shall avail such facility at their own Examination centre.

Principals of all Polytechnics are further requested to inform the candidates to appear Live Mock Test compulsorily from such device/exams centre wherever he/she has planned to appear in the actual Exams of 5th semester summer 2020 Exams.


From the experience of 6th semester online Exams 2020 it is observed that students do not appear Mock Test in spite of several round of awareness and also land up in problem of login and also unstable Internet Connectivity.

It is clarified that, arrangement of appropriate Internet connectivity of required bandwidth is the responsibility of the student concerned if he/she is appearing exams with Home based option and is the responsibility of Individual Institution where the students have filled up forms, if the candidate has chosen the Examination centre option.
